The County of Fisher has received an allocation from the American Rescue Plan Act program from the U.S. Department of Treasury and is soliciting competitive bids based on the Lump Sum Price for updating 2 Public Restrooms in the Courthouse.

Scope of Work:

Goals: Updating the two Public Restrooms in the Courthouse

Demo: Remove six stalls, tile, wallpaper, four sinks, and four fixtures in the restrooms. Take out two old built-in trash cans on the walls and two old feminine hygiene machines. Would like to have one restroom redone at a time while updating so the other can be utilized. Clean up all old material that has been removed and haul away.

Add six new stalls, tile, wallpaper and/or paint, four new sinks with counter space, two new fixtures, two new mirrors, and lighting. New exhaust fans, light switches, and plugs. Add two hand-drying stations. Need hooks in stalls for handbags etc. Add new toilets if needed (six total & two urinals) but not necessary if they are still in good condition.

Add on if needed: Update plumbing in the wall between bathrooms as needed.
