

# **ORDER OF JUVENILE BOARD**

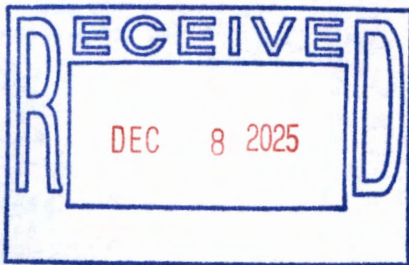
## **DESIGNATING JUVENILE PROCESSING OFFICES**

**IT IS THE ORDER** of the Fisher, Mitchell and Nolan Counties Juvenile Board in compliance with **Sections §52.02 and §52.025 of the Texas Family Code** have approved the following offices as suitable for Juvenile Processing Offices as outlined in Sections **§52.02 and §52.025 of the Texas Family Code**:

1. The following offices are designated as Juvenile Processing Offices for the purposes of returning child to custody of parent or guardian; completion of essential forms; photographing and fingerprinting; issuance of warnings; receipt of a statement by the child. **The period of that a child can be held in a Juvenile Processing Office cannot exceed (6) hours:**
  - (a) All Offices the Fisher County Juvenile Probation Department, Roby, Fisher County, Texas;
  - (b) Office of the Justice of the Peace, Room #113, Fisher County Courthouse, Roby, Fisher County, Texas;
  - (c) The Flex Office, Conference Room, Deputy Squad Room, Chief Deputy Office, and Sheriff's Office of the Fisher County Sheriff's Department, Roby, Fisher County, Texas;
  - (d) The Office of the Fisher County Judge, Fisher County Courthouse, Roby, Fisher County Texas;
  - (e) The Emergency Room of Fisher County Hospital, Rotan, Fisher County, Texas;

**THIS ORDER shall be terminated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 2027.**
