AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX RATE FOR THE COUNTY OF FISHER FOR THE TAX YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2019 – SEPTEMBER 30, 2020.

Be it ordained and ordered, by the Commissioners' Court of Fisher County, Texas
THAT:

WE, THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT OF FISHER COUNTY, TEXAS DO HEREBY LEVY AND OR ADOPT THE ROLL BACK TAX RATE OF \$0.757703 PER \$100 VALUATION FOR THE COUNTY FOR TAX YEAR OCTOBER 1, 2019 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2020 AS FOLLOWS:



TOTAL TAX RATE	<u>0.757703</u>

THIS TAX WILL RAISE MORE REVENUE THAN LAST YEARS BY AN AMOUNT OF \$447,219.00. WHICH A 13.485% INCREASES FROM LAST YEAR'S RATE.

Be it further ordered, that discounts for early payments of Taxes and split payments not be allowed.

The contracted Tax Assessor-Collector is hereby authorized to assess and collect the taxes of Fisher County with the ordinance.


